

Al-Sumait Prize 2016 Invitation for Nominations

The Amir of the State of Kuwait, His Highness Sheikh Sabah Al-Ahmad Al-Jaber Al-Sabah Jannounced an initiative to the third African Arab Summit hosted by the State of Kuwaik. This initiative described an annual award by the State of Kuwait for the advancement of economic, social, human resources, and infrastructure development in the African continent titled the "Dr. Abdulrahman Al-Sumait Rizze", after a Kuwaiti physician who spent his lifetime dedicated towards helping the poor in Africa in the field of health and education.

The objective of the prize is the appreciation, recognition of the best studies scientific projects, applied research, and innovative initiatives, which within the Health field have made existing at Impact and lasting influence in advancing progress to economic and social development in Africa. The awarded projects should help African nations to overcome poverty, hunger, lack of potable water, injustice or to improve health care, literacy and the allocation of economic resources. The Prize should also highlight successes within the following subjects: Food Security, Health and Education.

The subject for the 2016 prize is Food Security:

The prize is to be awarded to individuals or institution who through their research projects or initiatives have made significant advancement within one or more of the following areas:

Developing new varieties of seeds, crops or livestock whith can improve the food security of the poor

- population in Africa by increasing the calorific and registribinal value of food produced and consumed domestically.
- Improving farmers' access to agricultural imputs, leginiques, technologies and markets so as to increase the availability of staple products which forms core part of the diet of the poorest people in Africa.
- improving farmers' resilience to climate thange and extreme weather conditions.

Conditions and requirements:

- 1. The nominated candidates' research work or projects and initiatives must be innovative and must have achieved high-impact in line with international standards for the prize.
- The submitted work must be of paramount importance in promoting significant economic, social, human resources and infrastructure development in the African continent within the announced field of
- 3. Submitted research work of a nominated candidate should be composed of studies and applied research, published in referred journals and recognized at a global level within the announced field. The research outcome peops to have been applied after publication in African countries within the past ten years. Adequate supposing evidence needs to be provided.
- 4. Nominations are up to accepted from institutions and scientific centers (universities, institutes and centers of scientific seearch) as well as from competent regional or international and UN organizations and awards and increase winners in the field of the prize or former evaluation members. Nominations will only be accessed through institutions or other possible nominators mentioned above.
- All suppossions must be submitted in English.
