The State of Israel is to grant the above mentioned scholarships for the academic year 2022-2023 (for the duration of 8 months, starting in October and ending in June) as follows:

- 1. Applicants will be granted scholarships according to the following priorities: Post doctorate program, Research program, Ph.D. students, M.A. students and advance degrees in overseas program.
- 2. The scholarship is to include basic medical insurance and a modest monthly allowance for one academic year (8 months only).
- 3. Scholarships are to be granted only for universities and programs approved by the Israeli Council for Higher Education.
- 4. Applicants may also apply to the Ulpan language studies (summer courses) instead of the above mentioned scholarships.
- 5. Accommodation, transportation and travel arrangements to and from Israel are to be covered by participants themselves.

The Embassy of the State of Israel avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Turkey the assurances of its highest consideration.
