





Rules of the International Student Short Film Festival



3rd edition: from the 23rd to 26th June 2019

PREAMBLE:

The International Student Short-Film Festival, in its third edition, will take place from the 23rd to 26th June 2019 in Nabeul - Tunisia.

Competitive event; It aims to promote audiovisual knowledge and mobilize the creation and dissemination of cinematographic works by students from different countries.

Art. 1

The International Student Short-Film Festival is co-organized by the University Cultural Center of Nabeul and the University Cultural Center of Manouba, under the supervision of the Office of the University Services For the North, under The High Patronage of the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research and with the assistance of public and private organizations.

Art. 2

The International Student Short-Film Festival is open to fiction, documentary and animation films. It consists of several sections:

- A competitive section for short films: fiction, documentary and animation, made by students before **April 2019**.
- Off competition films.
- Practical workshops for students participating in the festival.
- · A competition for the best short film made during the festival.

Art. 3

The films presented will be chosen according to the criteria established by the jury and under the responsibility of the organizing committee of the International Student Short-Film Festival.

Art. 4

All films presented at the Festival must be in original version, subtitled in one of the following languages: French, English, and/or Arabic.

Art. 5

The jury, composed of experts and academics, awards the festival prize, and possibly other prizes granted by its exceptional or regular partners.

Art. 6

The jury awards the following prizes:

- 1. The first Prize of the International Student Short-Film Festival: The gold Laurel.
- 2. The Second prize: The silver Laurel.
- 3. The third prize: The Bronze Laurel.
- 4. The prize of the public.

The following awards are given to the director:

- 5. The Best Image Award.
- 6. The Best Soundtrack Award.
- 7. The Best Editing Award.
- 8. The Best Scenario Award.
- 9. The Best Female and Male Performance Award.
- 10. Award for The Best Short Film Produced During the Festival.

Art. 7

- a) The deadline for the registration of films in the competition is April 15th 2019.
- b) During pre-selection; copies of submitted films might be kept by the Festival.
- c) For the pre-selection, a registration form must be carefully completed on the website the International Student Short-Film Festival.
- d) Candidates must also provide one or more photographs of the submitted film, in JPEG format, in order to facilitate the constitution of the festival program.
- e) Expenses are entirely born by the students' institution or the student.

Art. 8

To participate in the third edition of The International Student Short-Film Festival, candidates must:

Submit the following documents through Google drive links:

- The film uploaded in mp4/mov and HD.
- A movie poster with high print resolution (300 Megapixel).
- Related documents: photos of the film (the shooting).
- 01 photo of the director.
- CV of the director.
- •A copy of the student enrollment certificate for the year 2018/2019.

Important: The registration of the film will be validated only after reception of the abovementioned documents.

Art. 9

Selection of the films will start on April 20th, 2019.

A selection committee, set up by the festival, will select from 25 to 30 short films.

It is possible for a director to present several films; however, the selection committee can only select one.

1/ The directors of selected films will be contacted directly by the organizing committee. They are expected to be present during the festival in Nabeul (Tunisia), knowing that they are taken care of during their stay (upon arrival at the airport for foreigners and a meeting point for Tunisian students). Two guests only are invited.

2/ Any film entered and retained for the competition cannot be removed from the selection. The 25 to 30 selected films will then be submitted to the jury's deliberations during The International Student Short-Film Festival, which will take place from 23rd to 26th June 2019. The jury being the only authority to select and reward the winners.

Art.10

Any film must have a duration not exceeding 30 minutes (including the Opening credits).

Art. 11

The selection of films involves the authorization of broadcasting clips / passaged on television and on the Internet, in the context of the promotion of the event.


Art. 12
