The Partnership for Global Inclusivity on AI (PGIAI) brings the U.S. Department of State and 8 major AI companies, who together announced plans to provide more than \$100 million, leveraging their combined expertise, resources, and networks to unlock AI's potential as a powerful tool for sustainable development and improved quality of life in developing countries, while maintaining an unwavering commitment to safety, security, and trustworthiness in AI systems.

It will focus on three main areas:

- 1) Compute: increasing access to AI models, compute credit, and other AI tools
- 2) Capacity: building human technical capacity
- 3) Context: expanding local datasets
